The idea was of course to show all the 15 possible types of h#2 Zilahi in positions where White has only king and pawns – variations on a theme producing a kind of cumulative composition. An article in *ORBIT* on this subject is planned for next year; in research for it I was surprised to find that (as far as I could ascertain – not easy!) only four of the types were previously extant in the h#2, although as the article will show, many interesting longer settings are possible. The problems here are unpretentious; more ambitious settings tend to be better expressed using white pieces.
