### Dr. SAVO ZLATIĆ [12.07.1912 - 8.12. 2007]

Roden je u Lanišču (Istra). Školovanje je proveo u rodnomu mjestu, Radeču (Slovenija) i Zagrebu. Maturirao je na I. realnoj gimnaziji u Zagrebu 1930. godine. Diplomirao je medicinu na Sveučilištu u Zagrebu stekavši naslov „Doctor medicinae universe“ (lječnik opće medicine) 1936. godine. Bio je izuzetno je uspješan čovjek kao stručnjak, zatim u svojem hobiju (problematski šah) te u privatnom životu. Kao politički angažiran i lijevo orijentirani student kasnije tijekom II. svjetskog rata bio je od prvih dana pripadnik Narodnooslobodilačkoga pokreta. Iza rata obavljao dužnost ambasadora u inozemstvu. Zatim je bio savjetnik za lijekove i medicinsku opremu u Ministarstvu zdravstva Hrvatske. Bio je pokretač te glavni i odgovorni urednik časopisa „Pharmac“ objavivši niz znanstvenih i stručnih tekstova.

Šah je upoznao sredinom dvadesetih godina prošloga stoljeća za vrijeme gimnaziskoga školovanja u Zagreb u svojoj 14. godini. Naslov „prvorazredni igrač“ stekao je kao član „Zagrebakoga šahovskog kluba“ 1929. godine. Prve je probleme sastavio tijekom trogodišnjega boravka u zatvoru (politički razlozi), prije II svjetskog rata, nacrtavši ploču na prični i izradivši figure od kruha. Direktni #2 iz toga razdolja objavljen je u tadašnjem „Šahovskom glasniku“ i odlikovan nagradom. U problemskom je šahu postigao naslov majstora problematskoga šaha šezdesetih godina prošloga stoljeća u vrijeme Jugoslavije. Medjunarodni je sudac FIDE za problematski šah od 1958. god. (I. kongres PCCC-FIDE u Piranu, Slovenija), počasni majstor FIDE 1999. godine (Netanya, Izrael) i nositelj trofeja Hrvatskoga šahovskog saveza. Bio je jedan od urednika časopisa „Problem“. Objavio je preko 150 problema u zemlji i inozemstvu osvojivši brojna priznanja. Pet je problema tiskano u Albumima FIDE.

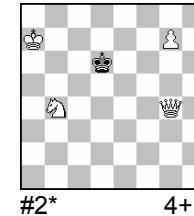
