


# Award in the formal tourney Maroc Echecs – 1<sup>st</sup> Ty 2011


47 compositions were participated and the level of the Tourney is good. My main criteria in judging were originality, complexity, economy, and the overall artistic effect. I propose the following ranking.



**1<sup>st</sup> Prize: no. 36.** A clear winner. Fourfold annihilation capture of the white indirect half-battery pieces and black interferences on four different lines. I. 1.Tf3: Se1: 2.Tf5 Sd3#; II. 1.Tg2: Tf4 2.Td2 cb4#; III. 1.Sf3: Sf4 2.Se5 Se6#; IV. 1.Sg2: Tf6 2.Sf4 Ld6#.


**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: no.47.** An economical record setting of black Loyd's Organ Pipis with mixed interference by the each white move in a well constructed position without white pawns. I. 1.Ld3 Tc4 2.Tc3 Se4#; II. 1.Lc3 Td4 2.Td3+ Sf3#.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: no.16.** Cyclic Zilahi and consecutive square vacation for the white pieces with consecutive passive captures of two white pieces in a heavy position. I. 1.Lc3: Sd7 2.Le5: Se5:#; II. 1.Tf6: c5 2.Ta6: La6:#; 1.Db7: Sd1 2.Db2:+ Sb2:#.






**1<sup>st</sup> Honourable Mention:** no.42. An interesting combination of white Rook Cross and white half-battery play. I. 1.Kc3: Tf1 2.Kc2 Tc4#; II. 1.Le5: Tff4 2.Lc3: Te7#; III. 1.Sd4 Tg4: 2.Se2 Tf3#; IV. 1.Se5: Te1 2.Sf7 Tc5#.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Honourable Mention:** no.35. A difficult setting of the reciprocal capture of white and black pieces in two pairs not enough harmonious solutions. I. 1.De1: Dc4+ 2.Ke4 Lg2:#; II. 1.Lf1: De4+ 2.Kc4 Tc1:#; III. 1.Kc6: Tc1:+ 2.Kb6 Da6#; IV. 1.Lc7 Lg2:+ 2.Kd6 De7#.

**Special Honourable Mention:** no.20. (After Z. Hernitz) Double alternate capture of the white line pieces Tc4 & Le5 in B1 move and four mates by the promoted Queen in two pairs not enough harmonious solutions with using of known matrix. I. 1.De5: h8D 2.De6 Dd4#; II. 1.Dc4: ed8D+ 2.Kc5 Dd6#; III. 1.Kc4: ef8D 2.Kc3 Db4#; IV. 1.Ke5: e8D+ 2.Kf4 De3#.




